pharmaCline, LLC is an innovative technology and pharmaceutical company that has developed a patent-pending drug delivery technology and game-changing product line of topical antimicrobial treatments.

After several years of successful foundational science, development and intellectual property generation pharmaCline filed for patent protection in the United States and internationally, regarding its Site Specific Penetration Technology (SSPT) and related products. Over the next three years the company anticipates developing nine new products designed to treat effectively wounds infected with MRSA, VRE, Group-A Strep, Acinetobacter strains, Staph saprophyticus, E. coli, Enterobacter cloacae, Klebsiella pneumonia, Proteus vulgaris and Pseudomonas aeruginosa.
